1ST NUCLEUS

In the past, there was a millstone of primordial importance in the milling system of the country and the Azores, along with windmills and water mills, which ensured the supply of flour and bread. The animals mills in the Azores are of the direct transmission type, with the driving wheel shallow from the ground.



3RD NUCLEUS
